<div>Vehicle CAN Bus Location</div>																							
<p>The CAN wiring is located at the OBD socket, lower drivers side dash or the speedometer wiring. Unclip the socket for access. The CAN bus wiring is a twisted pair of wires, identified as below:</p> <p>CAN HI = <b>PIN 6 (RED at the speedometer)</b>  CAN LO = <b>PIN 14 (WHITE at the speedometer)</b></p>																							
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<div>Testing The Installation</div>																							
<p><u>Connect the interface to the plug-in wiring harness and turn the vehicles ignition 'on'.</u></p> <p>The CANM8 interface switches on automatically when CAN activity is detected. The interface has an LED status indicator next to the connection plug, which will flash constantly when a CAN signal is present and has been identified by the interface.</p> <p>If the LED indicator is illuminated constantly, the interface is functioning but cannot identify the subject vehicle. It is very important that the interface is only connected to the vehicle CAN Bus wiring at the connection point location detailed at the top of the page.</p> <p>If the LED fails to illuminate or flash, the interface wiring has been connected incorrectly or no CAN activity has been detected. Check all electrical connections are sound and that the interface CAN HI and CAN LO connections are the correct way around. Also check that there is a good 12v supply present at the interface plug-in connector before seeking technical assistance.</p> <p>The CANM8 interface automatically switches off when the vehicle CAN Bus is inactive. This can be tested by removing the keys from the ignition, closing all vehicle doors and switching all auxilliary equipment 'off'. The interface LED should extinguish within 60 seconds.</p>
